Management, Committee and Board Reports

- Mayor's report – Resolution to pass a By-law for the adoption of the 2016 Budget; a tax rate of 9.03% has been approved for this year. An amendment to the resolution stipulates any cost savings the KPMG audit may find for this year be put in a stabilization fund for offset in 2017 Budget Year.
- CAO's report – Community Improvement Plan (CIP) update report submitted to Council, the project is in Phase 2. Resolution to pass a By-law for the adoption of the Employee Policy Manual was approved.
- Clerk's report – Resolution to direct the Clerk to incorporate the chosen meeting structure into the review of the Procedure By-law was approved.
- Building Controls / Municipal Law Enforcement Department report – Resolution to pass By-laws for the appointment of employees as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the monitoring of waste at bin sites and at the landfill depot was approved.
- O.P.P. – Monthly Municipal Policing Report.
- Public Works and Environmental report – First quarter report. Ad Hoc Committee Advising on Recycling Ecologically (CARE) has been selected; the Chair person is Councillor Malcolm Lamothe.

- Borrowing from Reserves - Motion submitted by Councillor Malcolm Lamothe. Council has directed staff to investigate the advantages and disadvantages of borrowing from our reserves to erase the debts and the impact of committing to a repayment into the reserve funds.
